Product Description:

AluWood panels consist of a durable aluminum sheet combined with slats made from thermally treated softwood. The aluminum is powder-coated in black, and the slats are available in both natural and painted finishes.

The slats are both glued and screwed in place, ensuring a durability of at least 20 years.

Produced in Denmark, AluWood exterior panels combine functionality with a minimalist design. They are crafted to enhance your home with a sleek, long-lasting solution that merges modern aesthetics with quality.

AluWood is CE-certified and meets European standards for construction products, complying with the Construction Products Regulation (CPR) EC Regulation No. 305/2011 and European Standard EN 14915:2013.

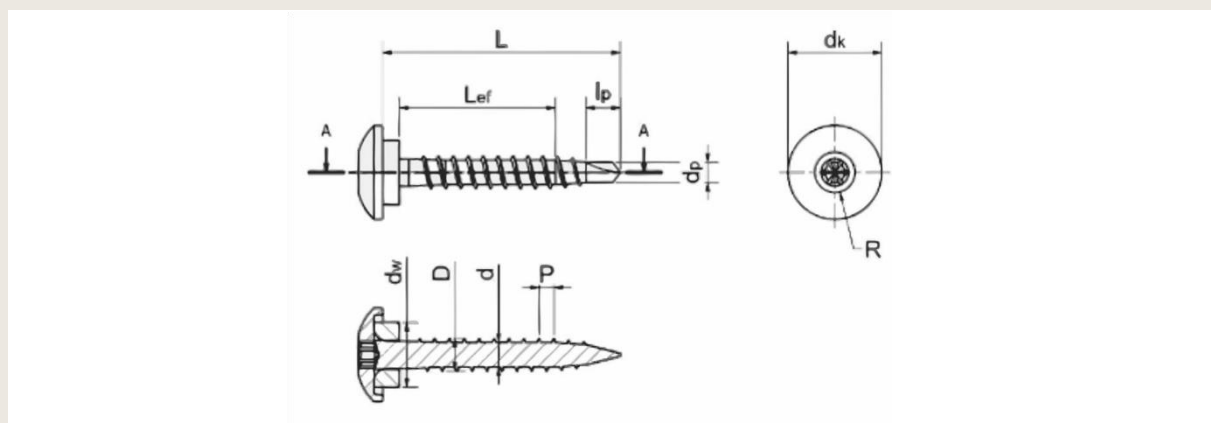

Installation:

AluWood panels are designed for easy installation, making them faster to mount compared to many other market alternatives, ultimately reducing project costs. The installation process is also accessible for DIY enthusiasts with basic skills, enabling them to handle simpler projects independently.

The panels can be mounted on wooden battens with a wind barrier. Any installation must allow airflow behind the panel. Only vertical installation is allowed.

When mounting AluWood on a roof, it must be installed vertically with a slope to ensure water runoff and prevent accumulation.

Safety Warnings:

- Wear protective glasses and gloves during installation.
- Be cautious of sharp panel edges.

Pricing:

Warranty:

- Warranty Period: 2-year warranty.
- Unlimited Support: Get assistance via phone, chat, or video to ensure correct installation.

Packaging:

Panels are securely packaged to prevent damage during transport.

Storage & Maintenance:

Store the panels in a dry place, protected from direct sunlight, before installation. Clean them regularly to maintain their appearance.

The wood is thermally treated and requires no additional maintenance. However, over time, exposure to UV light may cause a natural graying effect, and small cracks or surface splits may develop.

To preserve the original wood color, you can treat it with a water-based oil. However, once started, treatment must be continued as per the manufacturer's recommendations. Water-based oil does not damage aluminum, but if oil gets on the surface, simply wipe it off with a dry cloth.

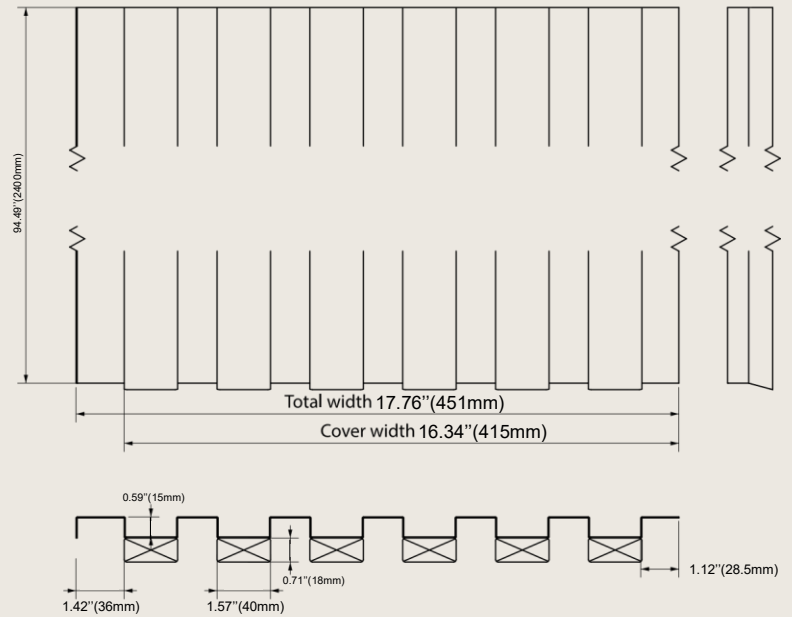
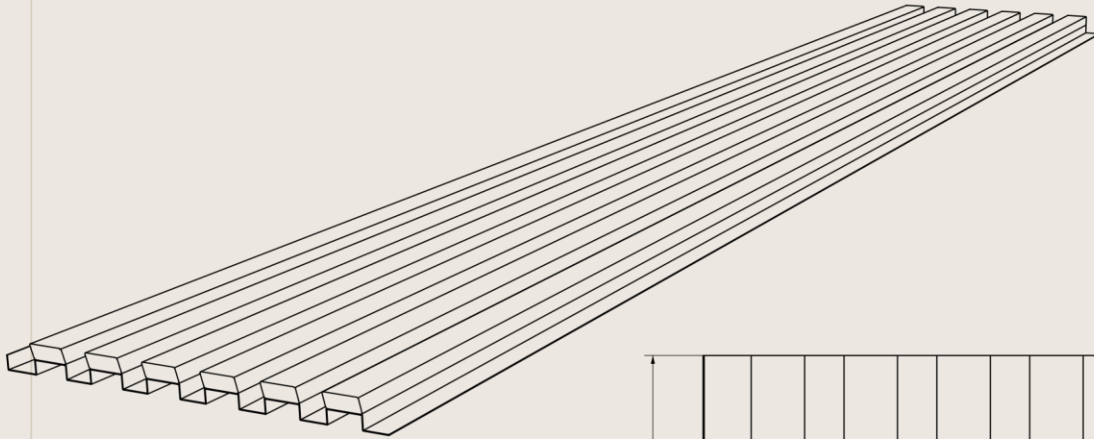
Production & Delivery:

- **Production:** AluWood is manufactured in Denmark at WoodUpp's factory in Skærbæk. Each panel is hand-sorted and thoroughly inspected before packaging to ensure the highest quality.
